Sub: Advisory to the Dental Professionals for COVID-19.

The undersigned is directed to say that the Dental Council of India noticed that the Dentists are being posted in isolation wards to discharge their duties under COVID-19. The Executive Committee of the DCI in its online meeting held on 13th May, 2020 has unanimously decided to issue an advisory to the effect that no Dentist/Dental Professional should be posted in isolation wards to treat the COVID-19 patients, which may put the patient at risk. A Dentist, however, can perform the following duties:

- 1. Pre-screening.
- Recording Case history and Identification of vulnerable age groups
- 3. Community engagement, Contact tracing and Patient tracking.
- 4. Health facility Infection control management
- 5. Administrative work related to COVID-19 from purchases, record management etc.
- 6. Health Dashboard maintenance and IEC related activities
- 7. Post discharge counseling and management of patients.
- 8. Review supply Chains and stocks of essential medicines
- 9. Organising capacity building and training for healthcare professionals.

Accordingly, the Dental Council of India hereby advise all the concerned authorities of the respective States/U.T.s/District Authorities etc. to follow the aforesaid guidelines/advisory.
